Board members Reports: Luiz requested information on our new resiliency grant. There was discussion on agency staff changes within CDFW. Joe Croteau has retired.

Agency Reports: Patterson gave an update on NRCS. Without a forester on staff, the program keeps getting further behind. He is attending the CARCD meeting in Folsom, this month. There was discussion on how the SVRCD can support NRCS with funding for projects that EQIP or FSA programs are not responding to. Drought requests for emergency assistance (example stock water) do not always receive priority funding from agencies in a timely manner.
